Aloha Hockey Players! This season we'll be starting the league with "Divisional Drop-In-Hockey" from Tuesday, August 19th thru Thursday, Oct. 9th. What is "Divisional Drop-In-Hockey"? It's very similar to pickup hockey with each time slot assigned to a specific skill level.

The program will allow for a total of 30 players (which will include 2 goalies) to have a pick-up hockey game for players with similar hockey skills for one hour.

- All required equipment will be mandatory.
- League jerseys will be required.
- A referee will be provided and all rules will be enforced.

The price for Drop-In-Hockey is \$13.00 + tax = \$13.61 per game with up to 14 players and 1 goalie allowed per team.

Goalies will not pay a game fee, but will only be permitted to register for one game per week. Lower level goalies may be used for the "A" Division if needed.

There are no refunds for games purchased. If games are cancelled by the rink due to low sign-ups you will be notified by phone or email to switch to another date.

ISI Registration for all players is required at time of registration. You must bring in proof of payment. If you have not yet registered for ISI you may do so at www.skateisi.org.

You must be evaluated to play in the Divisional Drop-In-Hockey Games. Upcoming evaluations are scheduled for Sunday, August 24th and 31st from 9:30 – 10:30am. You will be notified by email within 7 days of your evaluation.

All players are required to use full equipment including a HECC approved helmet with a full face shield and mouth guard. If you are unsure of our rules on equipment requirements you may view the it online at www.icepalacehawaii.com or stop by the rink to pick-up an Adult Hockey brochure.
